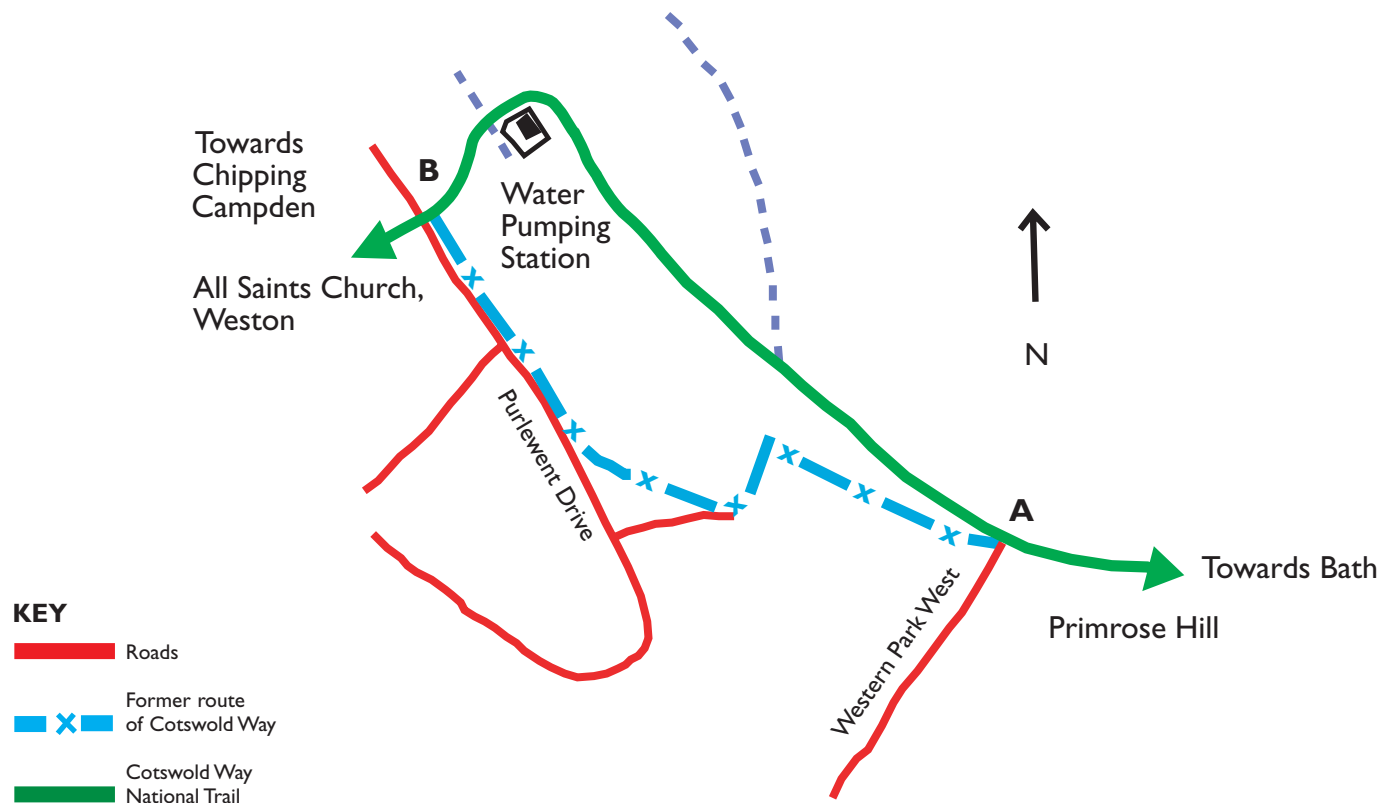


Route Improvement: Weston, Bath



KEY

Directions: (From the North) B to A

1. Cross Purlewent Drive and continue almost directly ahead of you up the tarmac drive and then a footpath to the kissing gate by the water pumping station.
2. Turn right in the field following the waymarks heading approximately south-east for about 200m to join the track.
3. Follow the track in the same direction to the metal kissing gate beside the field gate and continue ahead to where you will re-join the original route of the Cotswold Way.

Users of guide books detailing the original route:

The original route is still available for use on highways or public rights of way but is no longer signposted as the Cotswold Way. You will therefore need to navigate from the book for this section if you prefer to continue to use the old route.

Factfile for this route change:

Original route: approx 0.25 miles (A to B)
New Route: approx 0.27 miles (A to B)
Grid References: A(736663), B(732664)
OS Explorer Map No: 155

Reason for change: To reduce the amount of road walking.
