
Visit Bishopstone



A place to eat, drink, sleep and catch a bus

Bishopstone is a pretty village with thatched cottages, pond and popular pub lying only 1 mile / 1.6km from The Ridgeway National Trail. Follow the signs all the way into the village centre—the map below shows the route for walkers in yellow and the route for walkers, cyclists, horse riders and disabled people using large mobility scooters in blue. Enroute to the village, enjoy striking views of a dry valley and strip lynchets (ancient cultivation terraces on the sloped valley sides).
