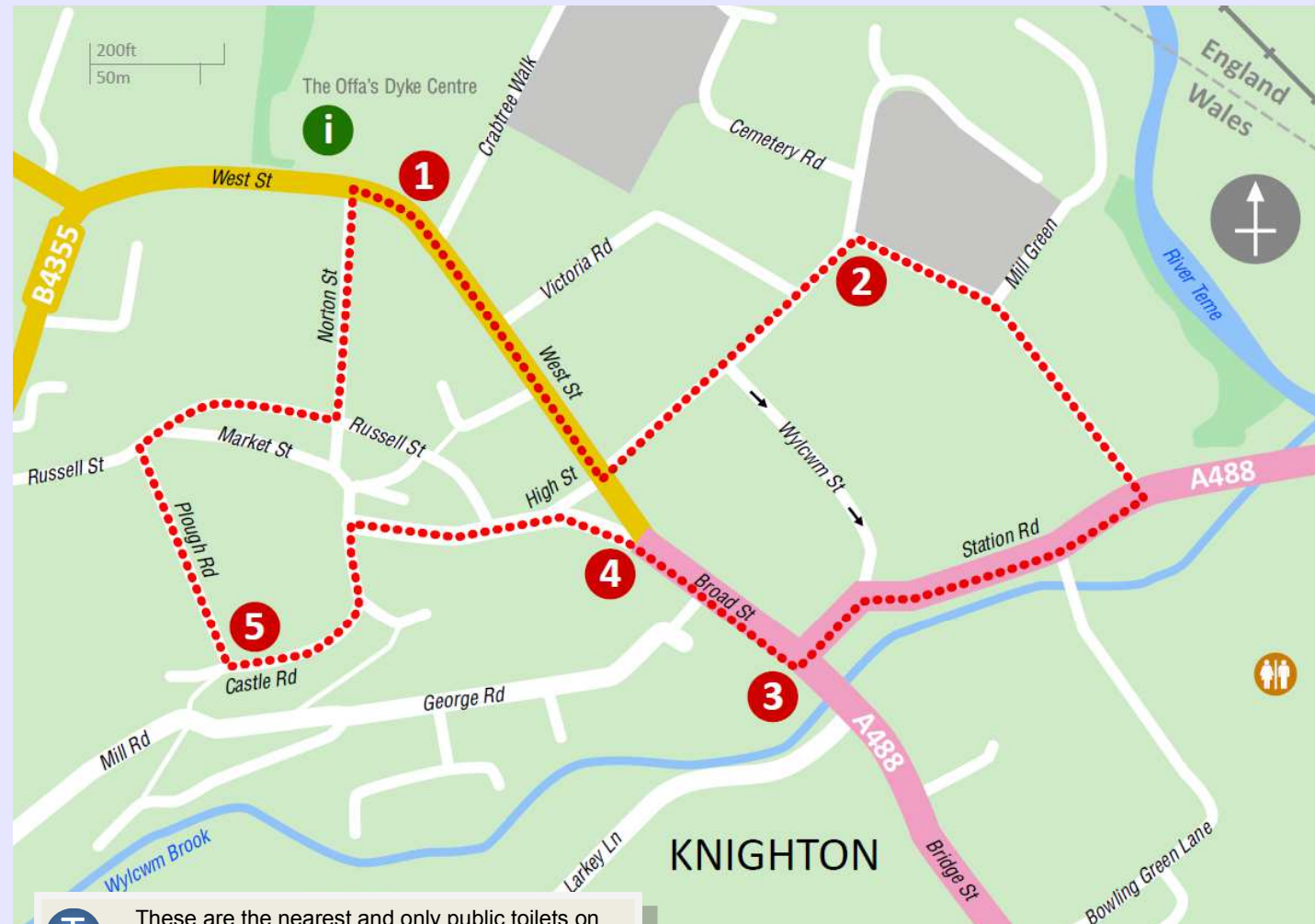


Irresistible Offa

Knighton

- 1 After a visit to the Offa's Dyke Centre, head downhill into town. Just before the clock tower, turn left down Church Street.
- 2 Turn right, along Church Road, keeping an eye out for interesting little houses. Turn right at the junction along Station Road, passing the Horse and Jockey pub on your right.
- 3 At the junction with the large hotel in front of you, turn left up Bridge Street to see what was once the timber-framed Old Mansion House, before doubling back and walking up Broad Street towards the clock tower.
- 4 The George and Dragon pub on your left and the buildings opposite date from the 17th century. Veer left at the clock tower up High Street, past Old House on your way up The Narrows. At the junction at the top, turn left, walking clockwise around where the castle once stood, along Castle Road, then first right into Plough Road.
- 5 Passing the fire station on your right, turn right and continue down to the Baptist Church on your left. Turn left down Norton Street and back to the Offa's Dyke Centre.



T These are the nearest and only public toilets on this walk, located next to knighton bus station. There are a few pubs that you pass on the walk located in the town that may have toilet facilities.
